General Criteria:

- This scholarship is open to students entering their sophomore, junior or senior year.
- Applicant must be a Catholic high school student in the Diocese of Grand Rapids.
- For males, applicant must be a participant in the diocesan discernment program.
- For females, applicant must meet with an assigned religious sister once a semester.
- \$1,000 awards will go towards high school tuition and may be renewed annually by request.
- Awards will start after the completion of the student's first year in the discernment program.
